I hope all is well! It has been a turbulent 2020, which no one could have predicted. The last time anyone had seen a world pandemic was 1918 during World War I and 45 thousand US troops overseas died along with 675,000 back home in the USA from the Spanish Flu or H1N1. As of this writing, the US is at 90,000 deaths from COVID-19. We have lost 111 Police Officers (Duty related) so far in 2020 to the pandemic, as reported by the Grand Lodge. The total amount of Officer deaths (Virus and other on duty incidents) has almost doubled from last year at this time. This clearly shows how vulnerable we are as law enforcement officers dealing with the public one on one. National President Pat Yoes is adamant about getting proper equipment (PPE) along with alcohol wipes and decontamination equipment to officers on the street and manning jail facilities. He has hosted meetings which all the state Presidents have been a part of. The meetings included white house and CDC officials. The saying here as I like to say, "Masked up Gloved Up be safe". I know we as FOP members and as Americans will get through this.



As I'm sure you have heard, a number of the gaming laws that were proposed in this past General Assembly were passed. Many of the bingo laws were passed however, after much discussion with President Ohrnberger and Legislative Chairman Marty Williams, the State FOP has decided to drop bingo as a fundraiser at this time. It may be revisited in the future. We will be discussing other options for raising funds for the State Lodge at the state conference, so if you have any ideas that would be beneficial to us, please bring those ideas with you.

While at Rally Day, I spoke with several of my state Delegates and expressed our views on much of the proposed gun legislation. While we were successful at getting some of the proposed legislation killed, much of it was still passed. We will continue to fight to keep our 2^{nd}

Amendment rights intact, but with the current state government we have, rest assured it will be an uphill battle.

The Southern States Conference scheduled for April was cancelled due to the COVID-19 virus. Additionally, we were not able to gather in Washington DC for Police Week to honor our fellow officers who lost their lives in the line of duty. Hopefully, we will be able to gather together next year to pay tribute to those officers.

National President Pat Yoes has announced that legislation has been proposed that would establish that officers who lost their lives due to the COVID-19 virus would be considered a line of duty death. Senators Charles Grassley (R-IA) and Corey Booker (D-NJ) cosponsored S.3607 the "Safeguarding America's First Responders Act" which says that officers who die from COVID-19 of any related illnesses are presumed to have done so in the line of duty. As of this writing the bill passed the Senate and has been sent to the House. Let's all pray that his bill passes.

I look forward to seeing all of you at the State Conference. I hope I have earned your support as I seek a second term as your Vice President. I hope everyone is doing well. Who would have ever thought that a virus could shut down our country? Let's hope a cure can be found soon.


When it comes to spending our money, I believe we need to look at our Rally Day that is held in January. The evening event that we hold cost thousands of dollars. The intent of the event was to get legislators to come so that members could meet their legislator and talk about bills the FOP endorsed and opposed. Unfortunately, several other events are also being held the night of the event and we are not getting the participation from legislators that we have gotten in the past. I believe moving the event location also hurt but the building is being remolded and we didn't have a choice in the matter. I believe that we should look at holding a directors meeting only and make it a one-day event not two.

At Rally Day, I spoke about new ways of fundraising. I found a company MobileCause that offers a software that allows text to donate campaigns that I believe would raise thousands of dollars. There is an annual cost for the service which is far less than we currently pay for phone solicitation. At the state conference we will hold a phone con-

versation along with an online presentation with a representative from mobile cause. I looked at several companies that offer this service for free, but they had no live customer service and would only respond to emails within several days. I believe you get what you pay for.

It was decided in May that we would stop playing bingo. It has taken many years of lobbing but FINALLY our great legislators have decided to allow Texas-Hold'em to be played as a fundraising event that will be monitored by the charitable gaming commission. I am hoping that the FOP can start sponsoring this event in January. I hope by the state conference I will have more information on this.

I hope this finds you surviving these uncertain times and the many drastic changes that have occurred in our work and personal lives. One thing is for certain, we will all be different when we come out on the other side of this situation. If you have a friend, co-worker, or family member that has been affected by this pandemic, my prayers are with you and them.

I would like to draw attention to something that recently disturbed me greatly. This was the recent decision by the Virginia Parole Board to grant parole to convicted cop-killer Vincent Lamont Martin, who murdered Richmond police officer Michael P. Connors in cold blood in 1979. This same Virginia Parole Board had rejected Martin's parole request just one year earlier. What changed in that year that has now earned him a release?

Fortunately, a group of key Virginia Republicans, including Senate Republican Leader Thomas K. Norment, Jr. and House Republican Leader Todd Gilbert wrote a letter to Virginia Governor Ralph S. Northam

protesting the action of the Virginia Parole Board. They stated in their letter that there were "highly irregular actions" by the Parole Board in the granting of Martin's release, including and ongoing investigation conducted by the Office of the Inspector General.

Fortunately, Martin's release has been halted until that investigation has been completed. But there have been several other recent releases that have also been questioned. The question has been raised as to whether the Virginia Parole Board followed Virginia law regarding notification of victim's families that the violent criminal was soon to be released on parole.

As stated by their letter, we owe it to the victim's family, to the Richmond Police Department, and to all Virginians to ensure that the process of granting parole is consistently legal, fair, and just.

The granting of parole to a convicted cop killer, who was convicted by a jury of his peers and sentenced to life in prison, is not only a travesty of justice, but is a slap in the face of every law enforcement officer who puts his life on the line every day to protect the citizens of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Virginia State Senator Mark D. Obenshain recently hosted a Parole Spotlight Series which can be viewed on his Facebook page. It includes an interview with former Virginia Governor George Allen, whose administration was instrumental in many positive changes in the Virginia parole system I would encourage you to watch Senator Obenshain and his guests discuss the shortcomings of the Virginia Parole Board. It will open your eyes!!!

The Mace of the House of Delegates

A ceremonial object symbolizing power and authority, a mace representing English authority was presented by Virginia's royal governor at Williamsburg in 1700. The House of Burgesses ordered a new mace about 1722. After the American Revolution, the House of Delegates sold the royal mace and deposited the money into the public treasury. This modern sterling silver mace with 24-karat-gold finish was made in England in 1938 and presented into Virginia House of Delegates by the Jamestown Foundation in 1974. When the House is in session, the Sergeant at Arms carries the mace to the House Chamber each day where it is displayed in front of the Speaker's podium. Today the mace is a symbol of the important political and legal traditions shared by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Great Britain.
